Perennials for Rockland

Perennials are plants with roots that live in the soil year after year even though the stems of most die back each winter. Most perennials bloom for a three or four week period, leaving their foliage to create interest throughout the rest of the growing season. Longer blooming perennials do exist, and can be added to the garden to extend the show of color. Since perennials grow in the same location for many years, it is important to consider their soil and light requirements when selecting them for a particular site. Some perennials require more maintenance than others, such as frequent dividing or staking. Other perennials are less demanding and require little maintenance. Perennials are beautiful on their own, but will also combine nicely with shrubs and annuals. The following lists name perennials that are especially suited for a variety of growing situations and uses.
